REGULATIONS GOVERNING SUBMISSION OF FILMS/VIDEOS

- 1) There is no entry fee.
- 2) Late entries postmarked **after February 29, 2008** will not be accepted.
- 3) You will receive a confirmation of submission.
- 4) All entries must have Aboriginal participation as outlined;
 - A. **Total Aboriginal Production: Producer, Aboriginal Director and or/Writer.**
 - B. **Collaborative Production: An Aboriginal and non-aboriginal joint production.**
 - C. **Aboriginal Theme Production: A non-Aboriginal production with the subject matter focusing on Aboriginal issues/stories.**
 - D. **A production featuring Aboriginal artist/technical content.**
- 5) Entries submitted in previous Dreamspeakers Festivals and not screened will be accepted.
- 6) Only DVD formats will be selected for preview. We are unable to preview Beta formats.
- 7) Each preview format (if selected for screening) must be prepaid, labeled and shipped in suitable mailing containers. Film/video title and filmmakers/video artists name must be legibly marked. 6% GST will be charged by Customs Canada on the stated value and must be pre-paid.
- 8) Film soundtracks must be optical.
- 9) The cost of returned film/video is the responsibility of the submitter. Please include a self-addressed stamped suitable mailing container to ensure the return of your video.
- 10) All shipments/correspondence shall be sent to the following address:

- 11) Productions may be color, black and white, sound or silent.
- 12) The entrant is responsible for the quality of the production (sound and visual)
- 13) Films/videos with commentaries or dialogue in a language other than English must be submitted or dubbed in English.
- 14) Participants are not entitled to claim any rental or other fees for screening of their film/video at the festival.
- 15) Any exceptions to festival regulations must be authorized by Festival Director.
- 16) The festival is not responsible for incorrect wording in Program Book or promotional kits where the "Call for Entry" form is incorrect or illegible.
- 17) Decisions regarding the screening of your work will be mailed **on or before May 1, 2008**.
